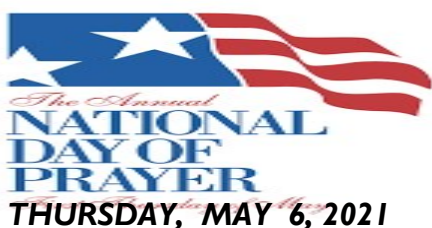
Members Who Are Home Bound:
