## MESSAGE FROM CHRIS...

### **The Glory of God**

*And you said, "The LORD our God has shown us his glory and his majesty...."*

Deuteronomy 5:24 (NIV)

"Glory" here is the Hebrew word [קָבוֹד/kabowd, /kaw 'bode/] which means, splendor, abundance, riches." The glory of God reveals part of His character, part of the essence of who He is, and is a beautiful description of what He shows us in this life. The magnificence of God is so hard to put into mere human language. How do you put into words the splendor, abundance, and riches of God? Our God is so beyond our comprehension; therefore, the best way we can describe His glory is to speak to how His glory is manifested in our lives.

As Spurgeon wrote: "We learn the power of Jehovah because we feel the littleness of man. Thank God, then, if you have been led by a rough road: it is this which has given you your experience of God's greatness and lovingkindness. Your troubles have enriched you with a wealth of knowledge to be gained by no other means."

The Glory of God is revealed in our lives as we reflect upon what He has done, is doing, and will do. His glory is what sustains us, His Glory is what changes us, and His glory is what drives us. The exciting part is that God has only begun to reveal His glory in our lives.

"Sovereign LORD, you have begun to show to your servant your greatness and your strong hand." Deuteronomy 3:24 (NIV)

Wherever you are in your walk with the Lord and as you think about all that He has done so far in your life, be reminded that God has only just begun to show you His greatness. He has only begun to show you magnificence and strength. His glory has brought you this far, and it is His glory that will carry you through. His glory is revealed in you.
